



STUDENT SPONSORSHIP POLICY

Rationale:

The College's student sponsorship for events program enables students to further their skills in a non-school setting. This may include State, National and International events.

Aims:

To assist students with expenses incurred when they excel in various activities.

- To reinforce, complement and extend learning opportunities beyond the classroom.
- To develop an understanding that learning is not limited to school, and that valuable and powerful learning takes place in places other than at school.

Implementation:

- State \$50.00 (*approximately – dependant on needs / expenses incurred*)
- National \$150.00 (*approximately – dependant on needs / expenses incurred*)
- International \$200.00 (*approximately – dependant on needs / expenses incurred*)
- Students will be required to provide a report to College Council after the sponsored event.
- Sponsorship may be in the form of cash, targeted expenses, vouchers or goods, at the discretion of the College Council.
- Teams will be considered as a group application.
- Submissions to be forwarded to College Council within four weeks of event.
- Funding may only be accessed once at each level (State, National, International) per student, per annum.
- Each case will be considered on an individual basis and will be at the discretion of the College Council.

Evaluation:

This policy will be reviewed every three years by College Council.
