Dear Parents and Friends,

Attitude to School Results

At Kyabram P-12 College we value student voice as a way of reflecting on what is happening, celebrating the positives, and improving areas identified as needing attention. The Attitudes to School Survey is an annual student survey offered by the Department of Education to assist schools in gaining an understanding of students experiences of our school. Students in Years 4-12 completed this survey early in Term 3 and this week we received the results. In recent years the 4-6 student responses have been overwhelmingly positive placing our school in the top quartile in the state. I am happy to report that not only has this continued this year, but our results across the Year 4–12 year levels are above 'like schools', 'Network schools' and State in almost every area. What a great result considering the interruptions and restrictions this year.

Year 12's Farewell

The Year 12 exams started on Wednesday 27th of October and continued until Monday the 15th of November. Their Graduation event is planned for this Friday, the 19th of November in the school hall. This is being carefully planned and structured to ensure we are adhering to the Covid safe practices such as vaccinations status and density limits. On behalf of the entire school community, I would like to wish our Year 12 class of 2021 every success in the future.

Transition Programs

Our school transition programs have stated up again, with our 2022 Prep students now able to attend afternoon structured sessions, organised to give the students a taste of school life. Our current Grade 6 students have been visiting the secondary campus and staff have blocked in times for Year 7 staff to visit the Grade 5/6 classrooms and share information. All families of Year 6 students have been invited to attend an interview to ensure we can provide the best possible start for each student. Semester 2 for all other year levels ends this Friday with the flying start program in place as of Monday 22nd. 
