School Operations update – Masks / Vaccinations

On Friday we received the latest update to the school operations guide. Below is the latest information. Thank you to all families for your support as we follow these requirements.

Vaccinations -

- Parents, carers, and other adult visitors not performing work must check-in using the QR code and need to show evidence of full vaccination when entering a school building. This includes for the purpose of activities such as school tours, kindergarten transition programs and meetings.
- Parents, carers, and other adult visitors attending a gathering at school, such as a fete, school play or graduation ceremony, whether indoors or outdoors, need to show evidence of vaccination on arrival.

Face Masks –

- Primary school students in Grade 3-6 to wear a face mask indoors at primary school unless a lawful exception applies. Students must wear face masks even if vaccinated.
- Visitors to primary schools must wear a face mask in all indoor spaces when attending the premises unless a lawful exception applies.
