Covid 19

While many things remain the same each year and we quickly get into the business of learning, Covid has of course brought with it many restrictions and advice which changes what we can do while at school. It has already impacted our staffing and students attendance because they have tested positive or are a close contact. To help manage the situation –

- All staff and students from Year 3-12 are mandated to wear masks inside (unless teaching)
- Parents / visitors drop students at the gate or Check-in via the QR code at the office if a visit is necessary
- Staff and students are encouraged to do a Rapid Antigen test twice during the school week.

If staff or students return a positive result, they must:


- Quarantine for 7 days

- Everyone in their household is a close contact and must isolate for 7 days.
