Transition Program

Our Prep Transition Program aims to provide our 2024 Kyabram P-12 College students with an opportunity to have a smooth, happy and exciting start to their school life. During transition sessions, students participate in engaging familiarisation activities, while spending time getting to know their possible classmates and becoming confident in the school surroundings. Our sessions include interactive literacy and numeracy activities, play based learning, as well as specialist activities including Visual Art, Performing Arts and Physical Education. Students will participate in a range of learning environments and will meet a variety of staff, including specialist teachers.
